

Supply Chain & Procurement Development Program:

The full time Supply Chain & Procurement Development Program provides selected high-caliber college graduates with the unique opportunity for a hybrid developmental experience, to rotate at least 3 times, into various roles within Supply Chain, Physical Logistics or Procurement over a 5 year period.

- Corporate Supply Chain is responsible for managing the flow of raw materials and finished product through the supply chain, including forecasting, production scheduling, and customer service. Nestlé USA offers a unique opportunity to work across multiple businesses, factories and 2,000 products.
- Procurement is responsible for ensuring and facilitating material supply to manufacturing facilities, ensuring suppliers have capacity to cover factory and contract manufacturer production requirements, initiate and maintain inventory requirements programs, develop positive and effective relationships with suppliers, and ensure supplier performance and service.
- Physical Logistics function is responsible for the distribution and transportation of all of Nestlé USA's product portfolio, which includes Ambient Chilled Distribution Centers, Factory Warehouses, Frozen Warehouses, Direct Store Delivery, Direct Warehouse Transportation and Nestlé owned transportation.

Work locations are based in corporate, factory and field (distribution center, customer service, customer facing) locations throughout the nation.
